### Rapid testing Home Kits

As part of a pilot, in partnership with Salford Public Health, we would like to encourage all adults who live with our pupils to undertake regular home testing for Covid-19. To help with this, school is able to provide all parents/carers with Rapid testing kits.

Tests should be undertaken twice weekly, 3 to 4 days apart. Each box of tests contains a really helpful leaflet and a video of how to take the test is available at [www.gov.uk/covid19-self-test-help](http://www.gov.uk/covid19-self-test-help). Please remember that these tests are only designed to be used by people who have no symptoms and school is providing these for adults in the household, not for children. If you or any of your household members develop any COVID symptoms, please arrange a PCR test instead. You can book a PCR test on the GOV.UK website or by calling 119. Please remember if the symptoms are non-classic Covid symptoms, you are now able to book a COVID-19 test and when prompted, click the box that says "My local council has asked me to get a test, even though I do not have symptoms".

If you are able to support our school community by undertaking these twice weekly tests and would like to arrange for your child to bring home kits for your use then please let us know by email [stpaulspeel.ceprimaryschool@salford.gov.uk](mailto:stpaulspeel.ceprimaryschool@salford.gov.uk) how many boxes you require (one box per adult).
