Just a few updates:

World Book Day:

Thank you to everyone who took part in World Book Day we raised £115.00 that will be used to purchase some new books for classrooms.

Snow Forecast:

The Met Office has issued a yellow warning of snow commencing at 3.00 am Thursday 9^{th} March until 16.00 on Friday 10^{th} March. If due to health and safety reasons and/or availability of staff school/some classes are unable to open messages will be posted on Class Dojo and the school website www.stpaulspeellh.co.uk

City of Trees:

On Friday (weather permitting) staff and pupils will be planting 210 trees in the school grounds behind Class 1 modular. These trees will create a new woodland and wildlife area in the school which will further enhance outdoor learning opportunities for our pupils. New woodland planting will provide habitats for birds, butterflies, bees etc. and can also help to reduce air pollution in the area.
