In the Summer Term children in Year 6 will take the SATs (Standard Attainment Tests.)

Year 6 children will sit tests in:

- Reading
- Maths
- Spelling, grammar, punctuation and vocabulary

The Year 6 KS2 SATs will be carried out in school during the week commencing 13th May 2019.

To fully prepare you and your child for the experience of SATs, we invite you to meet with us so that we can:

- Explain what 'SATs' are and how your child has performed in recent practise tests
- Talk through 'SATS' week and what will happen.
- Share what the tests may include and the types of questions the children will need to be able to answer.
- Explain how we can best prepare the children for this in school.
- Share ideas and tips for how you can help your child at home.
- Answer questions and concerns that you may have.
