I hope that you all enjoyed a lovely half term holiday; here are a few news items for you.

<u>Aldi Stickers</u> - Thank you to everyone who has already sent Aldi stickers into school, we have now filled two posters; that's 600 stickers! <u>Six Book Challenge</u> - I have received some completed challenge cards and some wonderful photographs of reading taking place in unusual safe places! If your child has taken part in the challenge please send completed cards and photographs into school by Friday, at the latest.

<u>Parents' Evening</u> - The Autumn term Parents' Evening is taking place on Tuesday 19th November after school, it is an opportunity for you to have a five minute appointment with your child's class teacher to find out how they are progressing so far this year. Appointment letters will be sent out later this week please put the date in your diary/phone as it is extremely important that your child sees you working together with us in school.

<u>Flu Vaccinations</u> - The nasal flu vaccinations are taking place this Friday (1st November); parental written consent has to be given if you would like your child to receive the vaccination.

<u>Payments</u> - All dinner monies/breakfast club monies <u>must be paid in advance;</u> via Parentpay or in cash to your child's classteacher.

<u>Breakfast Club</u> - It is a <u>requirement</u> that all parents/carers, who send their child(ren) to Breakfast Club, must enter the school building to complete the Breakfast Club register at 8.15 a.m.

<u>Attendance</u> - Our whole school attendance last half term was 95.37%, this is below our school target that has been set by the Educational Welfare Officer. Please remember that there is not an entitlement for pupils to take holidays in term time, no holidays will be authorised and parents/carers can receive a fine from the Local Authority.

<u>Poppy Appeal</u> - From Friday we are selling poppies on behalf of The British Legion, minimum donation 20 pence.
