

Mathematics in Year 1

During the Autumn term Year 1 children will be focusing on fractions, money and time. To help develop their understanding in these areas, parents can;

- Link fractions to their 2 time tables, use practical objects, for example; if you have half and I have half, how much will I have?
- Let the children count money, they need to recognise all coins and add them up and give change .
- Let them read the time, they will be reading o'clock and half past
