Here at St. Paul's Peel C.E. Primary School, the health and safety of all pupils, staff, governors and parents is of utmost importance. It is our duty of care to ensure that everyone is safeguarded. I would ask you to please read the following items.

Dropping Off and Picking Pupils Up

If you bring your child to school in a car, please do not block the driveways of any of our neighbours, park your vehicle on the pavement or on top of the yellow zig- zag lines for safety reasons. We have a new PCSO who along with Parking Attendants will be completing random checks. We do not allow any pupil to be picked up by anyone who is under 16 years of age.

Bicycles and Scooters

Bicycles and scooters of any size are not to be brought onto the school grounds.

Dogs

No dogs, of any type, size or age are allowed through the school gates and onto school premises, even if you carry them.

Smoking and E-cigarettes/Vapes

Smoking of any description is not permitted in the school grounds or premises.

Emergency Contact Details

Please ensure that if you have a new telephone number to let us know as soon as possible; so you can be contacted in the event of an emergency.

Swearing

Please refrain from using inappropriate/abusive language on school premises.

Facebook/Social Media Sites

We kindly ask parents not to post comments about school/staff/pupils on any social media site. If a parent would like to discuss anything, please make an appointment with the appropriate member of staff.

Smart Watches

A number of pupils have been lucky enough to have received a 'Smart Watch' for Christmas, for safeguarding purposes a watch which has the ability to access the internet, take photographs, records sound and videos, receives text messages are not permitted to be worn in school. Any pupils found to be wearing a device like this will have it confiscated and it will only be returned to the parent/carer.

Mobile Telephones

Parents are requested to not use their mobile telephones inside the blue gates; again this is for safeguarding reasons.
