Dear Parents/Carers,

What a very busy Spring 1 half term we are having, as we travel towards the half term break, here are a few updates for you:

Lateness: I can fully understand that occasionally due to sleeping in or transport issues that pupils can be sometimes late (I would rather have them arrive late than not at all) but this half term there have been 394 occasions where pupils have been recorded as late (arriving after 9.05 am). The school bell rings for the start of school at 8.55 am and all pupils should be waiting to enter school as the bell rings.

If your child is 5 minutes late or picked up 5 minutes early every day they will miss three days of learning each year.

If your child is 15 minutes late or picked up 15 minutes early every day they will miss 2 weeks of learning each year.
