### Science

This half term we will be exploring living things and their habitats, recognising that living things can be grouped in a variety of ways. This will allow the children to understand and use classification keys and differentiate between vertebrates, invertebrates, mammals, amphibians, reptiles, birds and fish. Our focus on a scientist will involve research into Dian Fossey and her work with Mountain gorillas.

### PSHE

In PSHE the children will focus on what constitutes a healthy relationship, working with their peers to explore notions of difference, identity, getting along, resolving misunderstandings and differences of opinion and working together to achieve mutual and individual goals.
