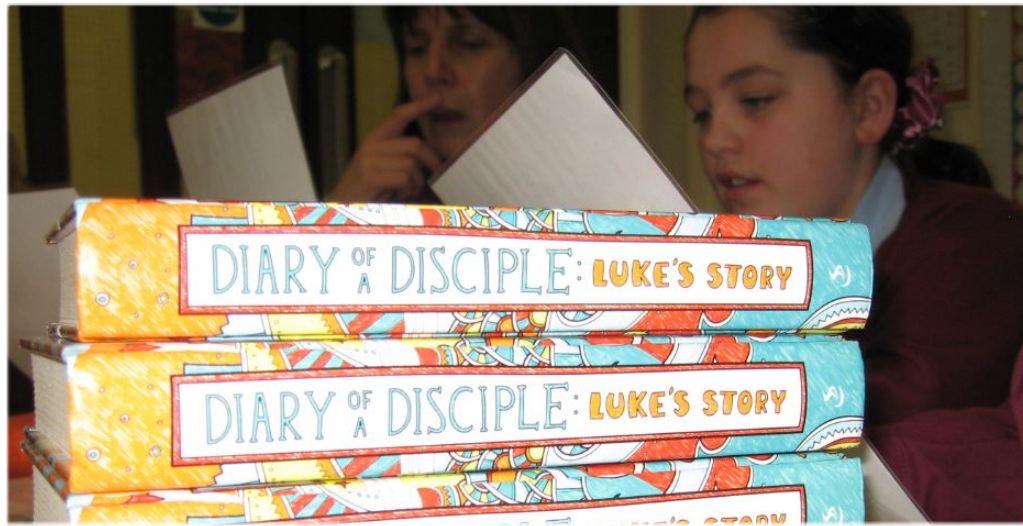


# St. Paul's Peel C of E Primary School
