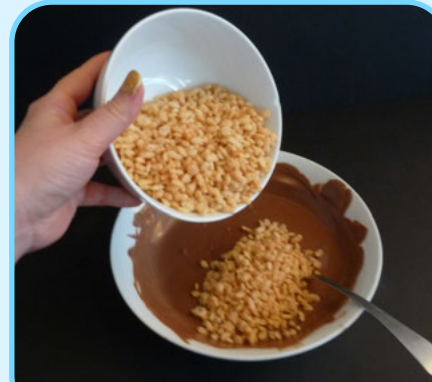
## How to Make Easter Chocolate Nests



You will need: chocolate, rice cereal, small chocolate eggs, cake cases, three bowls and two spoons.



1. Break up the slabs of chocolate and melt using a microwave or the hob.\*



2. Pour the rice cereal gradually into the melted chocolate.



3. Stir the mixture thoroughly until all the cereal is completely covered.



4. Separate out the cake cases on to a tray.



5. Using both spoons, transfer the mixture evenly into the cake cases.



6. Place the small chocolate eggs on top of the nests. Put them in the fridge to cool and harden.

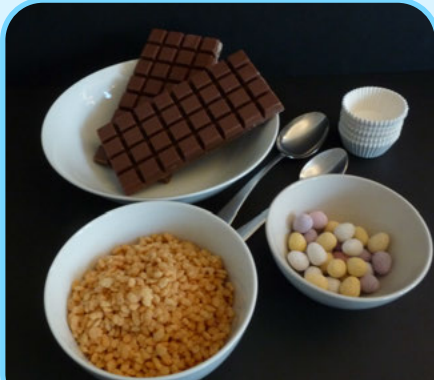


7. Take the chocolate nests out of the fridge and enjoy!

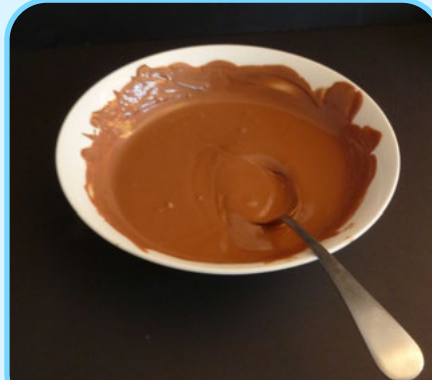
\*If using the microwave melt the chocolate for 10 seconds at a time. Stir the chocolate every 10 seconds. If using the hob place the chocolate in a bowl over boiling water. Stir continuously. An adult will do this part for you.



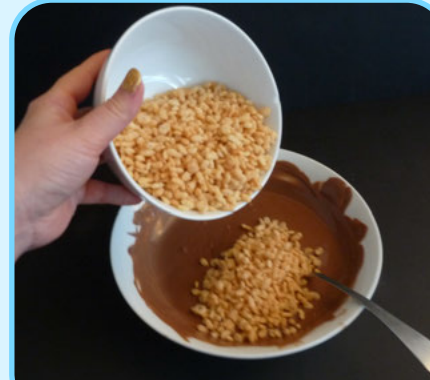
## How to Make Easter Chocolate Nests



You will need: 180g chocolate, 90g rice cereal, small chocolate eggs, cake cases, three bowls and two spoons.



1. Break up the slabs of chocolate and melt using a microwave or the hob.\*



2. Pour in the rice cereal gradually into the melted chocolate.



3. Stir the mixture thoroughly until all the cereal is completely covered. You may need to add more cereal if there is left over chocolate.



4. Separate out the cake cases on to a tray.



5. Using both spoons, transfer the mixture evenly into the cake cases.



6. Place the mini eggs on top of the nests before placing into the fridge to cool and harden.



7. Take them out of the fridge and enjoy!

\*If using the microwave melt the chocolate for 10 seconds at a time. Stir the chocolate every 10 seconds. If using the hob place the chocolate in a bowl over boiling water. Stir continuously. An adult will do this part for you.
