What do plants need to grow?



cactus

Where does it grow?

- Hot places
- Deserts



<u>Water</u>

It doesn't need a lot of water to survive. The roots are very long because they search for the little water around. It stores water in its barrel-like stem.



<u>Air</u>

- The spines on a **cactus** help to protect it from humans and animals.
- It has spikes on its body to control the amount of air it absorbs.



<u>Light</u>

• Cacti love light which is why they live in hot, sunny places.

Where does it grow?

Anywhere with the right conditions. (sun, water, soil)



<u>Water</u>

 It absorbs water through the roots and transports it up the stem to the leaves and the petals.



<u>Air</u>

A garden flower collects air through the leaves.



<u>Light</u>

Flowers need light to survive. It searches for light if it's hard to find. It absorbs light through the leaves to make food.
