Dear Parents/Carers,

I can't believe that we have come to the end of our second term in school; there has been lots of teaching and learning taking place.

Easter Holidays:

School closes today (Friday 1st April) at 3.30 pm for our Easter holidays, school reopens on Tuesday 19th April at 8.55 am.

Summer Term School Uniform:

- Grey or black trousers or skirts (not jogging bottoms or track suits)
- Blue checked/red checked dress
- Grey shorts
- Blue shirts/polo shirts
- V-neck or crew neck maroon jumpers/sweatshirts
- Black shoes (not trainers)
- White or grey socks/tights

COVID Update from Friday 1st April:

We have had a huge number of positive cases of COVID (pupils and staff) this half term, more than any other time and we have just about managed to keep every class open. However as new guidelines are in place (see below) please can I again ask that any pupil who is not 100% well does not attend school; it will be a very last resort to close a class.

- Adults with the symptoms of a respiratory infection, and who have a high temperature or feel unwell, should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people until they feel well enough to resume normal activities and they no longer have a high temperature
- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can come back to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, who test positive, the advice is to stay at home for 3 days or until 100% well

Absence Reporting:

I know that some of you are using Class Dojo to report an absence however teaching staff cannot guarantee that they will see Dojo messages if they are teaching or if they are off site.

So, could I please ask all parents and carers that the school office must be contacted if your child is absent from school before 9.00 a.m. each day.

School Kitchen Hygiene Rating:

I am very pleased to announce that our school kitchen had a routine visit from the Environmental Health Team and they have again been awarded a Food Hygiene Rating of 5 (the highest rate that is awarded). Well done to the whole team!

School Meals:

On Monday 25th April as well as a new menu, we will be operating a new system where you will be able to go online order meals from home, view recipes, check ingredient information and block dishes that contain certain allergens. Parent pay will still be in operation for payments.

How this will work:

- Pay each week in advance
- Pre order food each day before 8.55 a.m. with your child at home (you can pre-order for the whole week or term too)
- At lunchtime, your child will select their name from a touch screen and will be served the meal that you have both chosen

Before the day, you will receive an email from School Grid on how to set up an account with them.
